

general aspects of the interviews

- All three respondents were over 45 years old, all are married and have at least two children.
- They all work exclusively in the sheep sector and their focus is on the practical training.
- All have completed practical vocational training in the dual system and subsequently studied.
- ➤ All have been in their profession as trainers for at least 15, 25 or 33 years and
