

The main herd is present from two indigenous sheep breeds – White and Patch faced Maritsa sheep (local bulgarian sheep breeds).








 The shepherds and the sheep breeding are a traditional ancient way of life for many generations Bulgarians, deeply connected with our traditions, legends and folklore.
